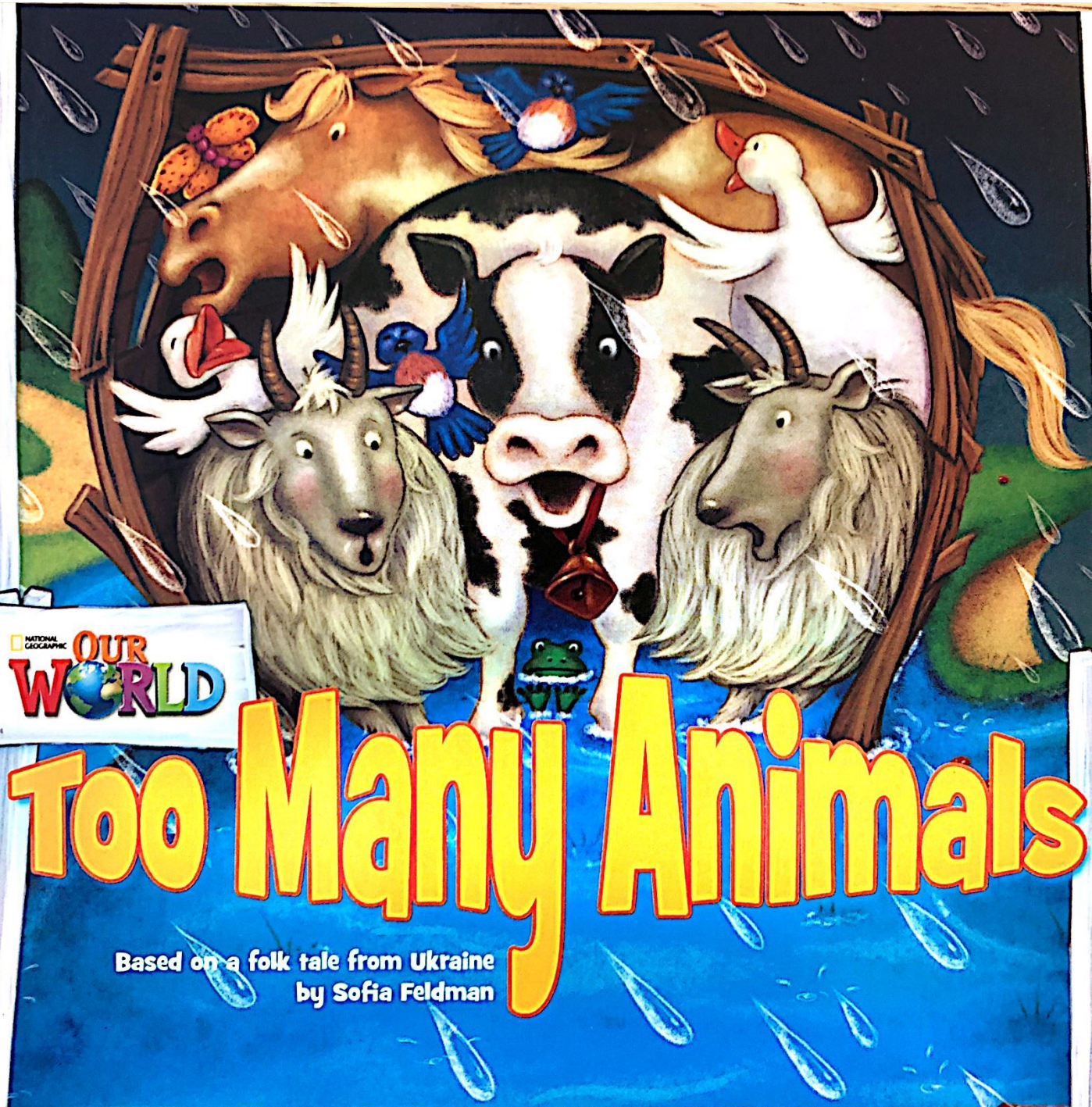




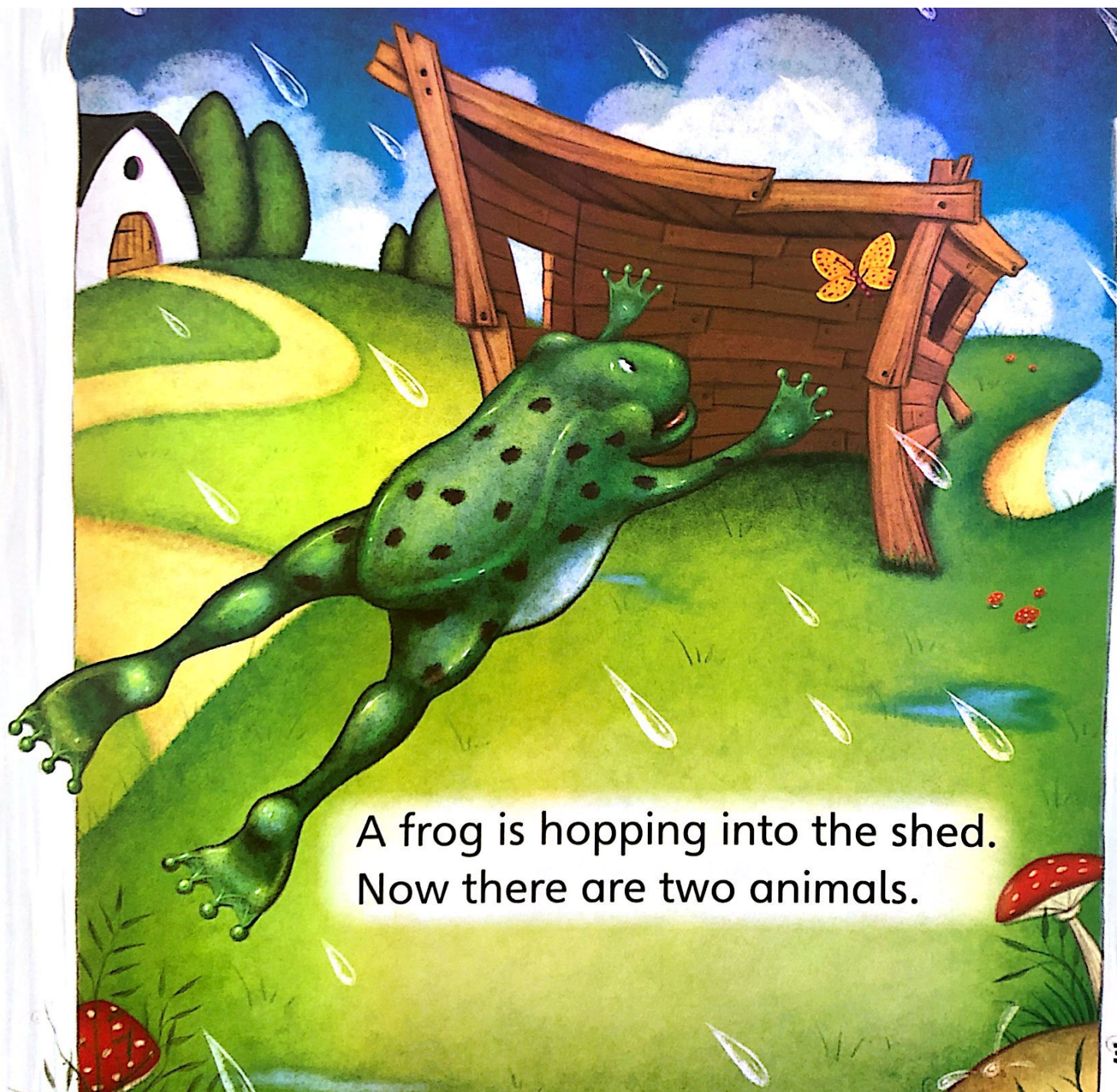

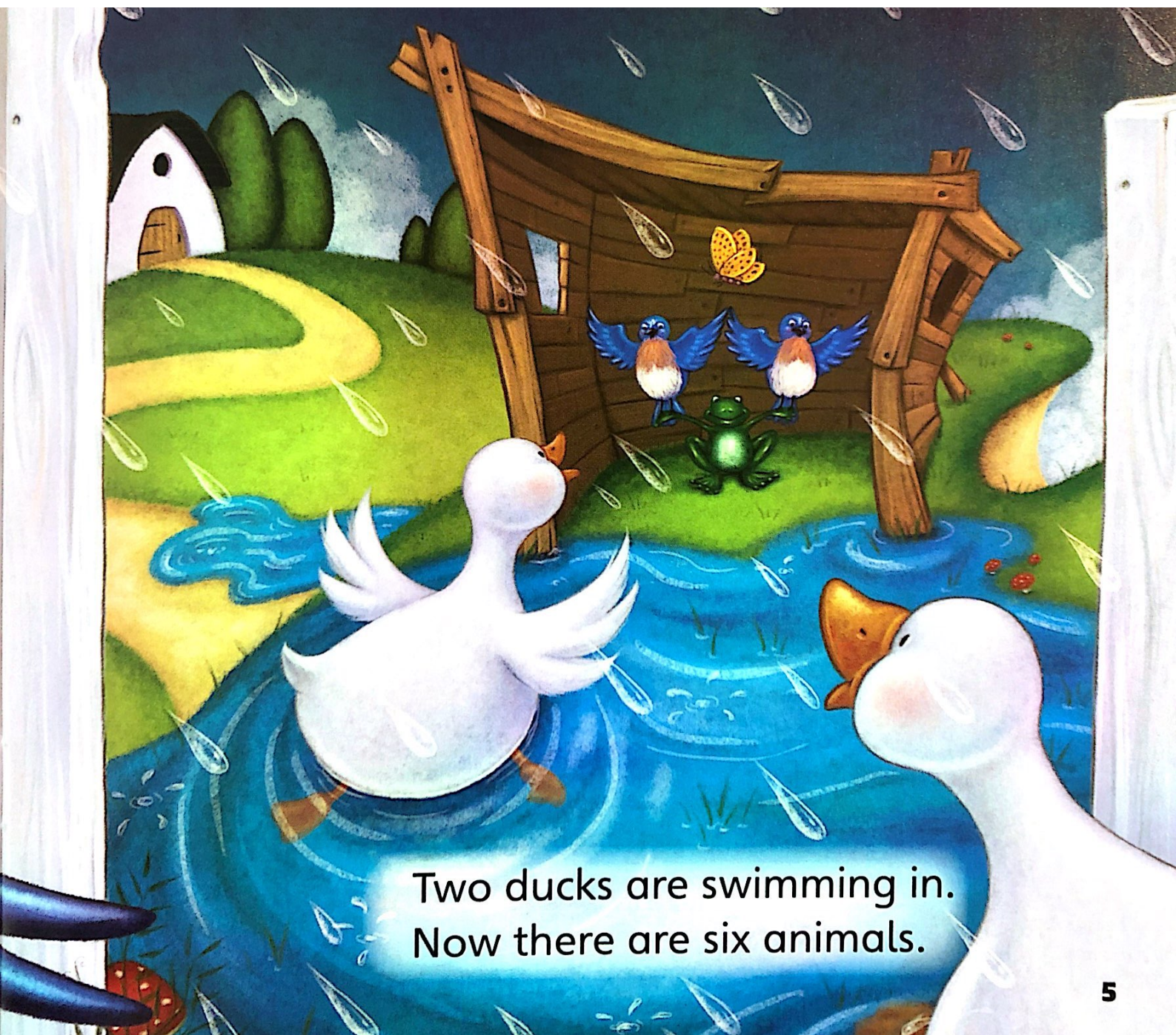


It is raining!

Now there are nine animals.

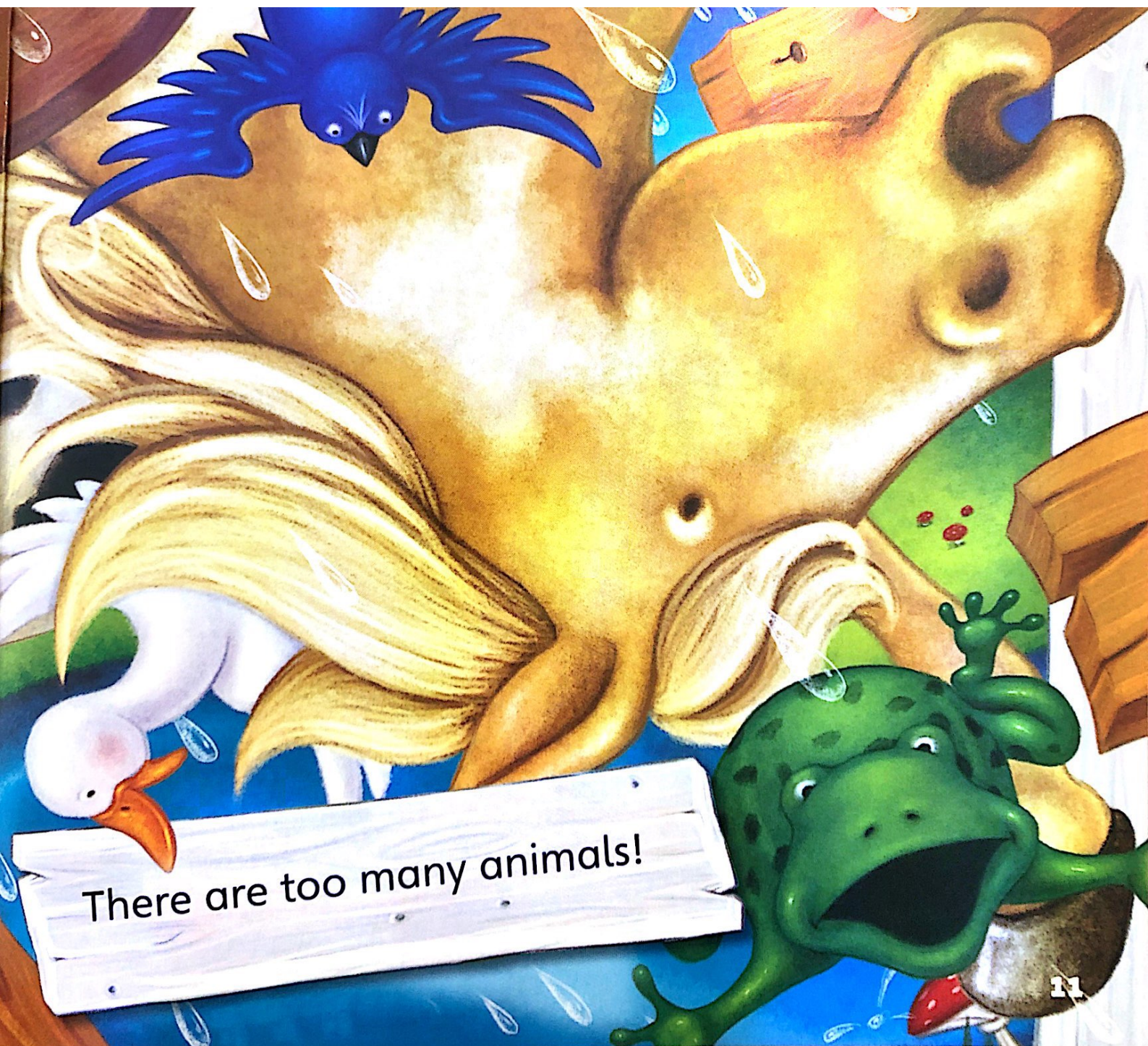


A cow is walking in.

A baby cat is called a kitten.



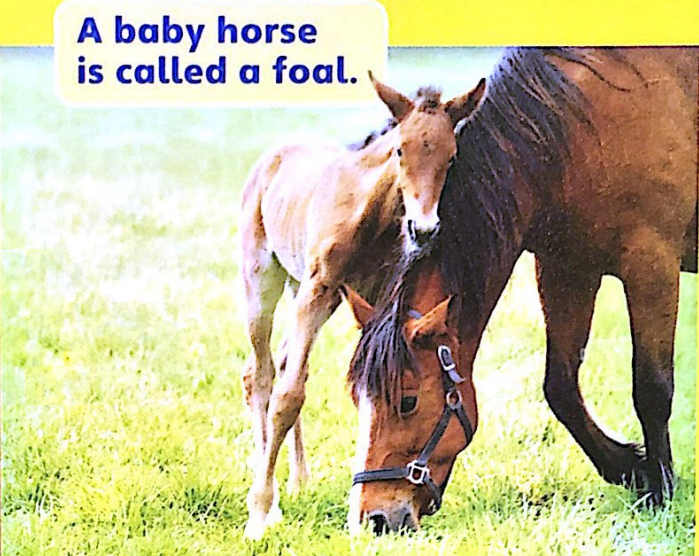
A baby duck is called a duckling.

A baby horse is called a foal.



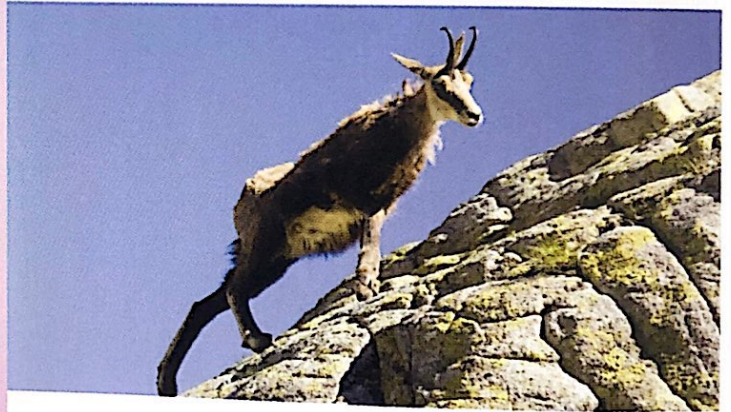
And a baby goat is called ... a kid!

4. A butterfly / duck can swim.

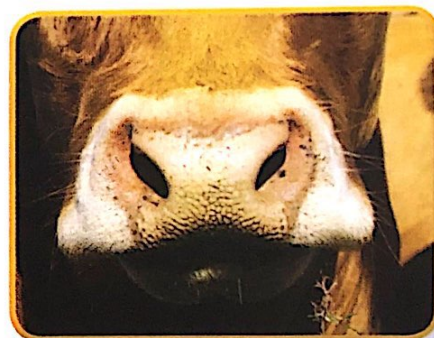
